BED BUG TREATMENT PREPARATION - COMMERCIAL BUILDING

A service technician will enter your property to treat for bed bugs.
Proper preparation is required to achieve the best results. Please follow these instructions completely. The better prepared you are, the more effective the treatment will be.

The technician will not be able to treat if other pest control products have been applied. Please do not apply other pest control products before or after professional pest control treatment.

All individuals must leave the premises during the treatment. No one must enter the property for at least 2 hours after treatment is completed. Those who are pregnant, have health concerns, or under the age of two years old must not return for at least 4 hours after treatment is completed.

Upon reentering the property, if possible please open windows to ventilate for 15 minutes.

You must be prepared when the technician arrives. The technician will not be able to wait for you to prepare for treatment.

1. Pull all furniture and other objects 12 to 18 inches away from walls and cubicle walls.
2. Remove as many objects as possible from floors.
3. Vacuum all floors thoroughly. Throw away vacuum bag or clean bagless vacuum thoroughly.
4. Do not stack anything on office chairs, desks, or other furniture. Items may be placed in a bathroom or kitchen area during treatment.
5. Cover all televisions, monitors, computers, keyboards, and all other electronics with plastic.
6. Cover fish tanks and turn off air filters.
7. Cover and put away all food items.
8. If you have noticed bed bugs in specific areas, please notify maintenance or leave a clearly written note for the technician.
9. After treatment you may vacuum all floors. Remember to throw away the vacuum bag or thoroughly clean bagless vacuum.
